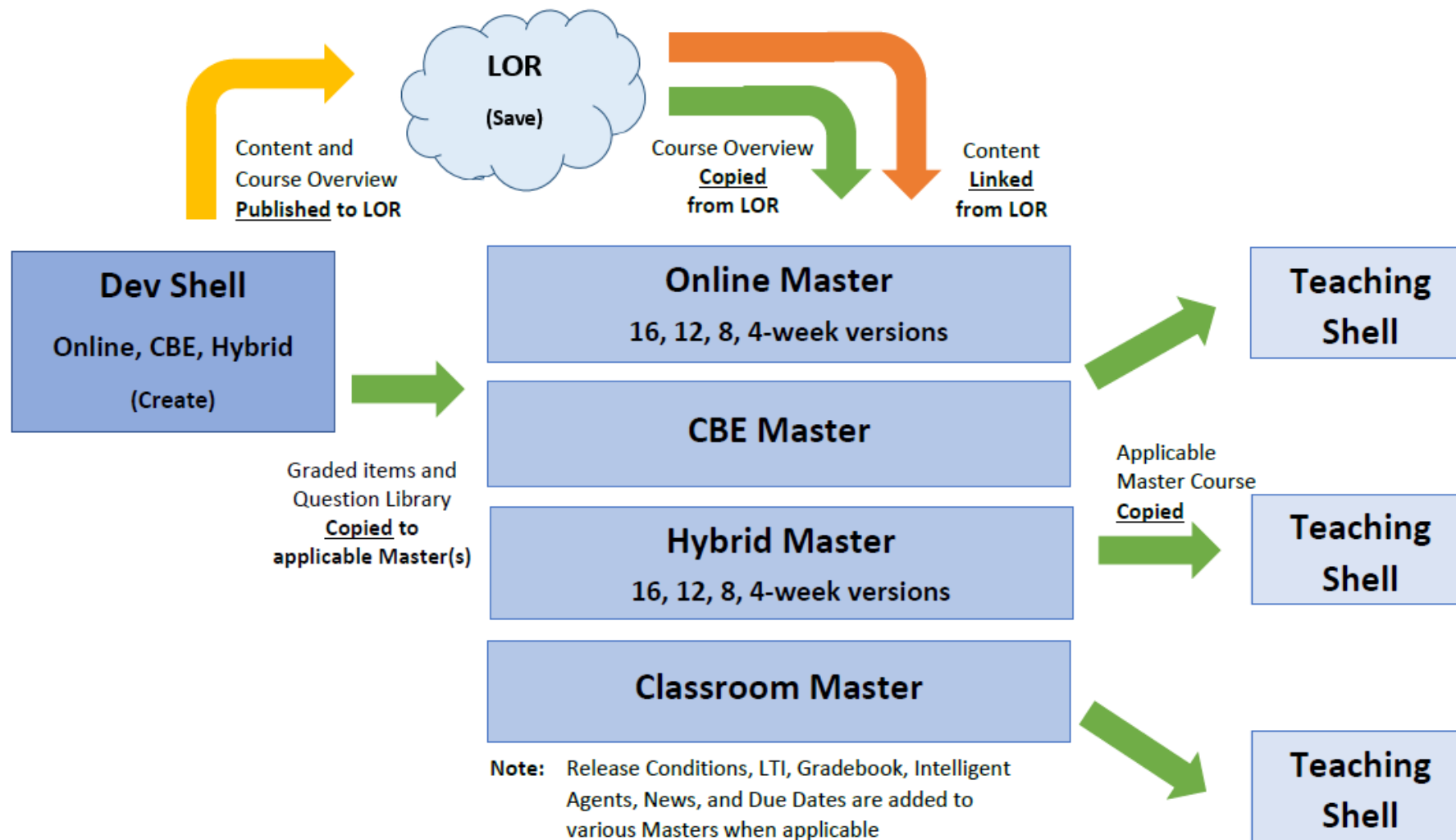


# Further Benefits of Using the LOR
